Instructions to parents of infants to be baptised

1. No special dress is required. Dress the child in white or pastel colour.
2. You will be assigned a place to sit in the sanctuary.
3. Do not worry or be embarrassed if your child should fidget or cry a little. However, if the child bawls before or after the baptism, you may bring him/her out as you pleased.
4. The child(ren) should be brought by the parent(s) personally for baptism.
5. The amount of water applied will not affect your child's health. However, please bring a towel to dry.

Questions to be put to the parents of infants to be baptised

1. Do you acknowledge before God and this congregation that as children of Adam, you as well as your dear child(ren) are sinners, lost and undone, that apart from the saving grace of the Lord Jesus, all are lost and doomed to Hell?
2. Do you acknowledge once again the Lord Jesus Christ as your only Lord and Saviour and that of your child(ren)?
3. Baptism does not save your child(ren) but it shows your earnestness to claim God's covenant of grace upon your family.

Do you promise that at the earliest opportunity you will bring your child(ren) to know the Lord Jesus Christ as his/her own personal Saviour?

4. Do you acknowledge that, although our children are conceived and born in sin and therefore are subject to condemnation, they are holy in Christ, and as members of this church ought to be baptised?
5. Do you promise to instruct your child(ren) in the principles of our holy religion as revealed in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, and as summarised in the confession of Faith and Catechisms of this church?
6. And do you promise to pray with and for your child(ren) to set an example of piety and godliness before him/he/them, and to endeavour by all the means of God's appointment to bring him/her/them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord?
